# **Irregular Verbs in English: A Complete Guide**

### For example:

Regular verb: play → played

Irregular verb: go → went (not "goed")

# **How Are Irregular Verbs Different?**

Regular verbs follow a consistent pattern:

· Base form: walk

Past tense: walked

· Past participle: walked

Irregular verbs change in unpredictable ways. For example:

Base form: run

Past tense: ran

Past participle: run

Tip: The past tense and past participle of irregular verbs often don't follow any specific rule. Memorization and practice are key!

### **Common Patterns in Irregular Verbs**

Although irregular verbs don't follow fixed rules, some patterns can help you group them:

## 1. Verbs with All Forms the Same

Base form = Past Simple = Past Participle

These verbs do not change at all.

# 2. Verbs with Same Past Simple and Past Participle

Base form ≠ Past Simple = Past Participle

The base form changes, but the past simple and participle forms are identical.

# 3. Verbs with All Forms Different

Base form ≠ Past Simple ≠ Past Participle

Each form of the verb is unique.

Base form and past forms have a vowel change

The verbs undergo changes primarily in vowels.

Past participle form ends with "-en"

These verbs have a specific suffix in their participle forms.
